1 Culture Hall



Uchinada Cultural Hall houses a large auditorium, several meeting rooms, a library, and more. A variety of events and ceremonies are held throughout the year in the auditorium, and the library has a collection of over 100,000 books.

2 Lover's sanctuary



3 Obama Shrine



The shrine as it is now was built by the Kaga Clan in the Gorojima area of Kanazawa in 1832. It was later moved to the Onebu area of Uchinada in 1889. During the Warring States Period, people would come to the shrine to pray for victory.

4 Sunset Bridge



This elegant cable-stayed bridge is the symbol of the town. The bridge is lit up at night with different colors based on the time and season, creating a romantic atmosphere. At neighboring Sunset Park, you can grab some soft-serve ice cream and buy locally produced honey and vegetables.

5 Sunset Wing



This windmill is powered by the ocean winds that blow in from the Sea of Japan. It produces 2,550,000 kilowatts of electricity each year, about the same amount of energy used by 700 households.

6 Observation Tower



From this observation tower, located in the Multipurpose Park, one can see both Mount Hakusan and Mount Tateshima. There are also tennis courts, a baseball field, an indoor pool, lodging facilities, as well as natural hot springs.
